ELECTION RESULTS

Any amendment to the bylaws requires the approval of 2/3 (66.66%) of our 74 members for passage. A total of 57 ballots were cast on or before the due date of July 31, 2024. The final results were 53 Yes votes and 4 No votes. The amendments to the bylaws passed with the approval of 71.6% of the total members. The bylaws are hereby amended in accordance with the membership vote.
