

EPPOA Pavilion Reservation Agreement



Homeowners are allowed to reserve the pavilion for a private event with Board approval. Use of the pavilion can be requested through the Waterfront Chairperson. To be able to reserve the pavilion you must be in good standing with all dues paid. Use of the pavilion does not give you exclusive rights to the pavilion, but you are able to use the pavilion for your event. When reserving the pavilion, the following conditions apply.

- * The pavilion must be returned to the way it was found with all furniture back in place.
- * All garbage must be taken to the road trash bins after the event.
- * Quiet hours start at 10:30pm so parties should begin winding down at 10pm.
- * If the event has amplified music this should end at 10pm.
- * The homeowner that reserves the pavilion is also responsible for the following.
 - * Liability for event attendees
 - * If Police issue a fine or ticket
 - * Any damage that is caused to pavilion or property during the event
- * 4 hour maximum reservation
- * 40 guest maximum per reservation
- * No reservations allowed on Memorial Day weekend, 4th of July (including the weekend that Twin Lakes celebrates), Country Thunder weekend and Labor Day weekend.
